

The purpose of the Princess program is to promote Agricultural Fairs and to create better relations between youth and adults in both rural and urban settings.

Contestants Must:

- Have exhibited at the Williamsburg Community Farm Show (this may be the first year they exhibit something, this may include art, photography, livestock, or anything else that the Farm Show has to offer)
- Be 8-15 years of age on June 1, 2025
- Have parent/guardian consent to participate
- Sign a Code of Conduct agreement
- Be available the week of the farm show August 17-23, 2025 for miscellaneous fair activities.
- Must be available for miscellaneous duties at the Farm Show even if not chosen as Farm Show ambassador.
- Attend community organization events to promote the Williamsburg Community Farm Show
- It is at the discretion of the fair board and queen coordinators regarding the holding of multiple crowns/title during their time as Williamsburg Farm Show Royalty.
- Be of good moral character

Components of Contest:

- Biographical Information
- Introduction
- Impromptu question with judge
- 100 word essay "Why you should come to my fair"
- Agree to behavioral policy

Farm Show Queen and Princess Behavior Policy:

The contestant's governing board shall have the sole discretion to determine whether, in its judgement, the Queen, Alternate, Princess or Contestants may continue to participate in the program. In the event that the board determines that any statement or representation is not true and accurate, or that any action is inconsistent with the rules, standards, and dignity of the program.

The following will be considered violations of the policy and will be grounds for immediate disqualification, dismissal, and/or being banned from future Royalty competitions.

Infractions include:

- Any illegal activity including stealing.
- Smoking, drinking alcoholic beverages, chewing gum, foul language, and/or public displays of affection to significant others while wearing crown and/or sash and representing the queen and court program.
- Engagement in any illegal, nonpartisan, unethical, indecent, and/or morally questionable behavior, including but not limited to, online representations on the internet such as social networking sites (Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, Snapchat, etc.)
- Any defamation of the Queen Contest, its winners and contestants, and the fair or the PA Fair Queen Program and their directors and committee members; whether it be oral or written. This includes postings on the internet.
- Any uncooperative or unsportsmanlike conduct before, during, or after the competition.
- Appearing in crown and sash at any event without an official invitation from an authorized event coordinator or event board member.
- Any behavior brought to the attention of the Fair Queen Coordinators or Williamsburg Community Farm Show that have been determined to be unacceptable or not in alignment with the values of the Williamsburg Community Farm Show.

Dress Code:

Wearing of the Farm Show Queen and Princess crown and/or sash is to be considered an **honor** and **privilege.** The bearer is now an ambassador representing herself, her family, her community, Therefore responsible, appropriate, and professional appearance is expected while the Queen and Fair Princesses are in their crown and/or sash:

Attire that is conducive to the specific appearance or event (i.e. business casual, formal, etc.)

Absolutely NO:

- Jeans
- Leggings as pants
- Sweatpants
- Shorts
- Sneakers
- Flip flops
- No visible facial piercings. (Earrings are acceptable)
- Outfits that show cleavage
- No visible tattoos.
- Boots:
 - o cowboy boots
 - work boots
 - o riding boots

Alterations may be made to this jean-footwear rule **only** if:

- Severe weather or unsafe conditions exist and
- The Farm Show Queen's official chairperson/coordinator has approved an alteration consistent with the professional appearance expectation

It is strongly recommended that closed toe shoes be worn in livestock areas, for safety reasons.

Dresses/skirts must be no shorter than the width of a dollar bill (approximately 2.5") from the bottom of the dress/skirt hem to the top of the knee cap

No clothing that advertises, promotes, or glorifies the use of alcohol, tobacco, drugs, or anything inconsistent with the dignity of the queen program.
